



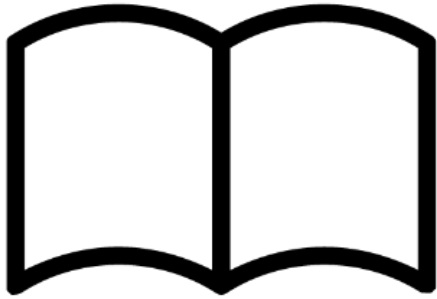

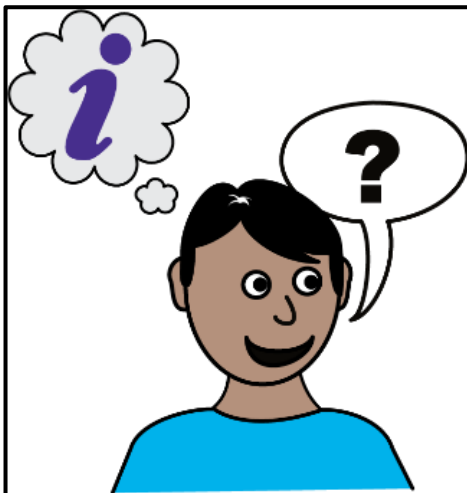

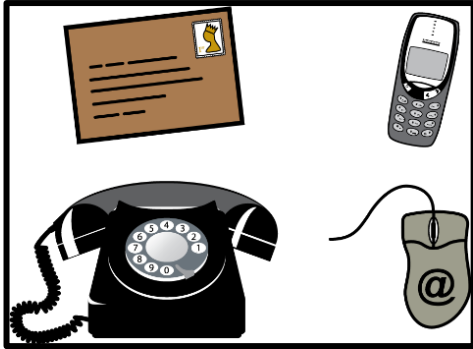

You can tell us you want to join the **Disability Inclusion Advisory Council**.

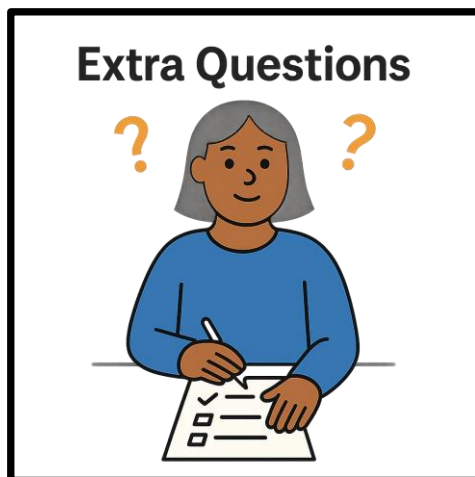
# Chairperson role

The **Chairperson** runs meetings and helps the Council work together.



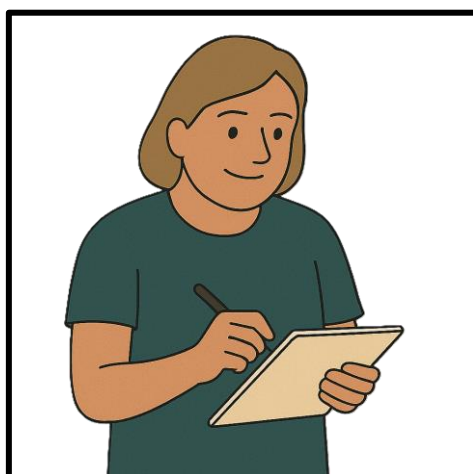
If you want to be **Chairperson**, we will ask you extra questions about leading groups.

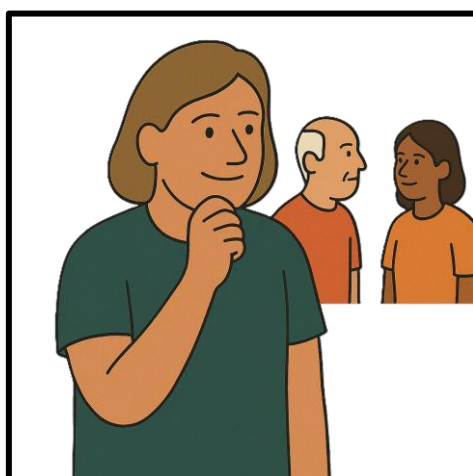

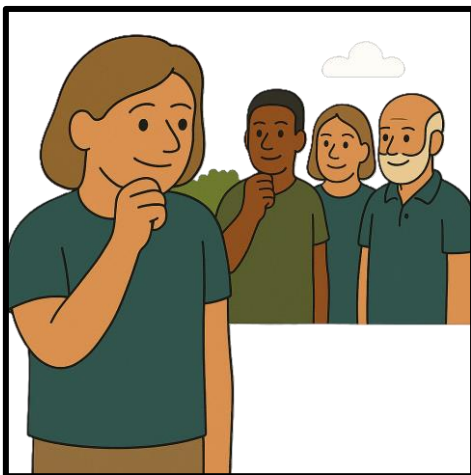

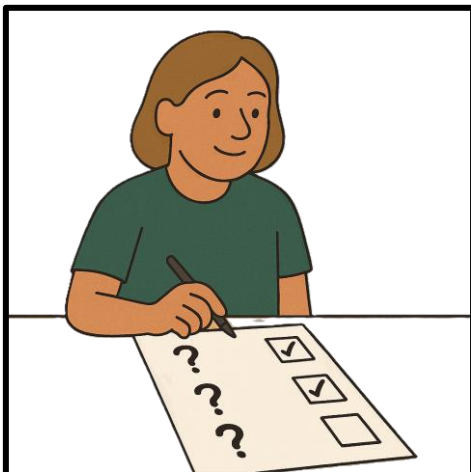
